Objectives

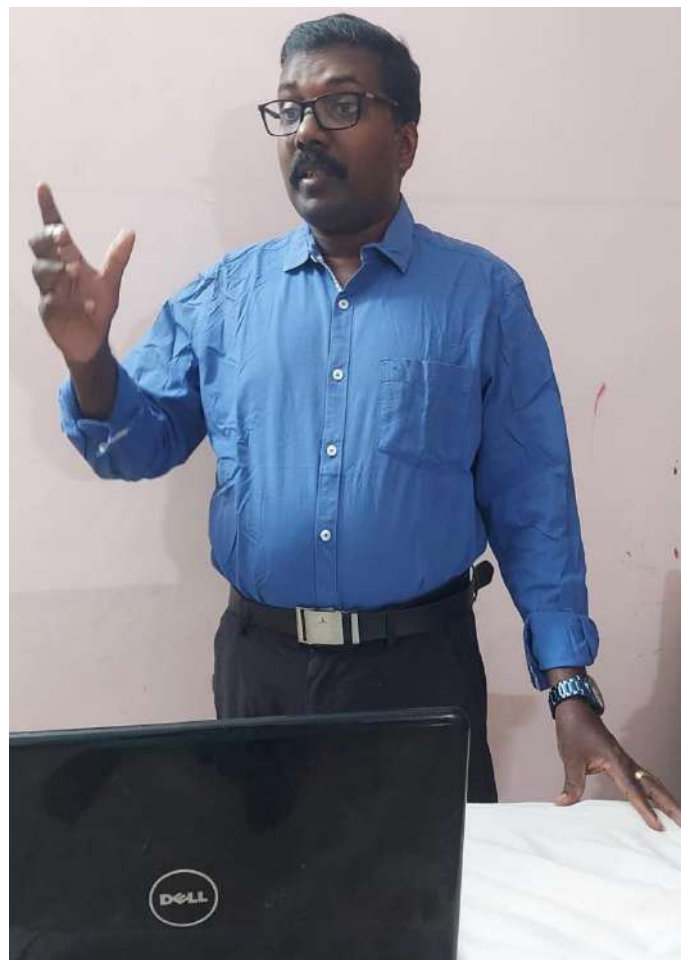

The program also intended to bridge the gap between theoretical botany and its practical application in the forensic field.

Program Outline

This is complemented by the role of phytoplankton's in investigations.

Objectives

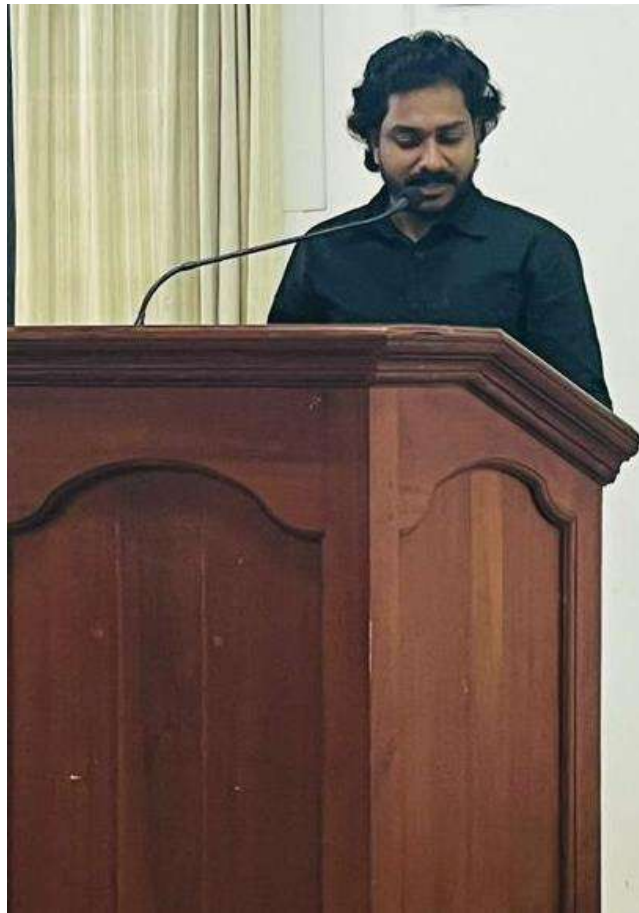

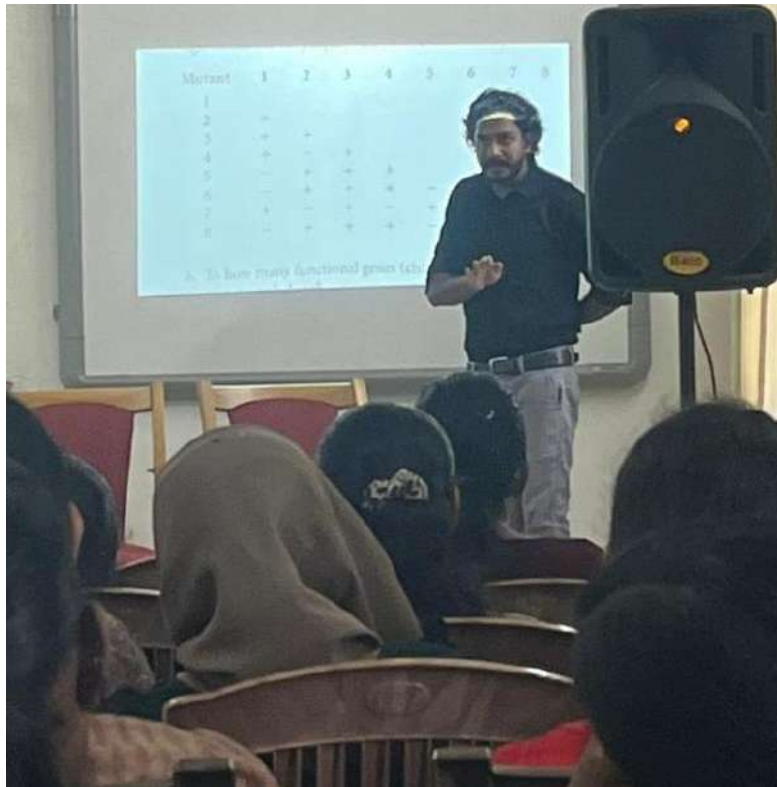
Program Overview

Conclusion



CAREER GUIDANCE REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2019-2020



The Department of Economics organized a session on ‘personality development and career counselling’ for first-year and second-year degree students on July 28, 2019. The session was led by Dr. Jayaraj, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychology. 110 students from first-year and second-year degree classes attended the session.

Dr. Jayaraj began the session by discussing the importance of self-awareness and self-confidence. Objective





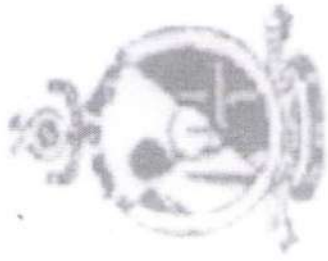
