**A Report on the “First Online Parents - Teachers Meeting of
S2 B.Com. Degree (2020 Admission)” held on 06th August 2021, Friday.**

The agenda of the meeting was as follows:

- Introducing new teachers transferred from other colleges, to parents.
- Discussion on the conduct of online classes;
- Discussion on the attendance of students in online classes;
- Analysis of first semester online internal examination results.

The first Parents Teachers Meeting (PTM) of Second Semester B.Com. Degree class started at 7.00 pm in online mode. The program started with silent prayers and remembrance of Acharya, Bharata Kesari Shri. Mannathu Padmanabhan (Acharya Anusmaranam). The meeting witnessed around 90% attendance thus displaying enthusiastic interest among parents for the smooth working and progress of the college.

Sri. Vishnu Gopan, (Class Tutor of Second Semester B.Com. Degree) welcomed the participants of the meeting. After this, Dr. Dileep A.S. (Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Commerce) presided the meeting and delivered the Presidential Address. Sir, briefed many things regarding online classes, importance of attendance of students in online classes, examinations, etc. in his speech. He also pointed out that the declining attendance of students was unbearable and the department could not tolerate it. The PTM was inaugurated by the most respected Principal of Mahatma Gandhi College, Dr. Ambili M. and addressed the participants who presented over there. The meeting then proceeded into the discussion of various agendas one by one.

Dr. Jayadev S., Dr. Pradeep Kumar N., Dr. Vinod A.S., Dr. Sumitha R., Mr. Rakesh S., Adv. G. Radhika, Ms. Minu Balakrishnan, and Dr. M.S. Gayathri Devi, has spoken from teachers' side and many parents as well as students also expressed their views and opinions on various matters. The teachers provided specific guidelines and suggestions for each student during the meeting with the parents. The guidelines were primarily focused on students' performance in classroom and exams. The parents were informed about the students' performance during the first semester internal examination and preparation for upcoming university semester examination. Discussions were focused on student's specific strengths and weaknesses in individual subjects and student discipline

in online classrooms. The meeting reached the following decisions through the consensus of all.

1. The parents appreciated the efforts taken by college and departmental levels for the conduct of effective online teaching.
2. The parents expressed their support and solidarity with the teachers' concerns about the decline of students' attendance during online classes and they assured that they would pay more attention to increase and maintaining high students' attendance level in online classes.
3. It was decided to give special consideration to those students who lost regular online classes due to college sports activities or as part of NCC/NSS activities or having internet connectivity issues, and as per their requirement, to provide the missed classes in extra class hours.
4. It was decided to follow current class timing and class pattern, as it is convenient for all the students.

The Outcomes of the PTM:

A total of 74 participants, including 64 parents and 10 teachers participated in the first PTM of second semester B.Com. Degree class. Parents became aware of the institute's rules and regulations, methodologies of teaching & learning for the overall welfare of students. Parents were encouraged to appreciate student's participation in all academic activities. Parents appreciated the efforts and the individual attention given to every child despite it being via an online platform. Though there are certain difficulties in online sessions, despite this, many parents feel that online classes are a great initiative to gain visibility on their performance. As a joint effort, parents agreed to keep a close vigilance on the actions of their child, and to keep inconstant touch with the teachers.

Conclusion:

The PT meeting helped to create better understanding between parents and teachers and build harmonious relationship between the college, department and the community. Parents were encouraged to appreciate student's participation in all academic activities. The meeting advised all participants to maintain social distance, wear masks, be vaccinated and be safe to follow the Covid 19 protocol.

Mr. Rakesh S. (Assistant Professor), extended the vote of thanks to the participants of the meeting.

The meeting ended at 9.00 PM with a national anthem.
