

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


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Details of the Activities Undertaken

Upskilling of SHGs:

Based on a series of discussion with the Panchayath President and Other Officials and field visits, UBA, Mahatma Gandhi College was able to shortlist around 10 SHGs who had expressed their willingness to associate in this programme.



Identification of Skilling Project

A series of upskilling projects related to value addition to food products (banana chips, pickle making, paper bags...etc.) were discussed. Group discussion was undertaken to identify the prospects of these projects in the local area, the optimal utilization of the support system available in and around their panchayat and the scope of marketability of these products to achieve sustainability in the long run.

Selection of Viable Project

Based on the inputs received through the Group Discussion (GD) with SHGs, we had shortlisted some of the projects for second round of discussions and viability studies. Based on these inputs from the local community and the participants we had initiated the first project for the manufacturing of LED. An LED stands for "Light-Emitting Diode." which is an electronic device that emits light when an electrical current is passed through it. Early LEDs produced only red light, but modern LEDs can produce several different colors, including red, green, and blue (RGB) light. Recent advances in LED technology have made it possible for LEDs to produce white light as well. Since LEDs are energy efficient and have a long lifespan (often more than 100,000 hours), they have begun to replace traditional light bulbs in several areas. The energy efficient nature of LEDs allows them to produce brighter light than other types of bulbs while using less energy.


