# Report on “ Awareness Program on Higher Education and Job Opportunities”

## Introduction

Held on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2019 at seminar hall, this program was attended by 51 students. The programme was designed to bridge the gap between academic learning and real-world career opportunities, providing valuable insights into the ever-evolving job market and higher education landscape.

## Objectives

The primary objective of this awareness program was to equip students with the knowledge and tools necessary to make informed decisions about their educational and career paths. It aimed to expose students to a wide range of higher education options, including specialized courses, research opportunities, and global study programs. Another key goal was to provide insights into the skills and qualifications sought after in the current and future job markets, thereby guiding students in aligning their academic pursuits with career aspirations.

## Program Outline

The program was structured into several key segments to maximize its effectiveness. Initially, Dr. Cinthya Christopher provided an overview of the current higher education scenario, highlighting various advanced study options both domestically and internationally. This was followed by a detailed analysis of emerging fields and the skills required for future job markets. Interactive sessions focusing on career planning and development were also included, along with a segment dedicated to understanding the linkage between academic specializations and corresponding job sectors. The program concluded with a question-and-answer session, allowing for a personalised interaction.
