Report On Orientation Lecture for CSIR-UGC NET Life Science Examination and Higher Studies

Introduction

PG & Research department of Botany, recently hosted a significant Career Development Program focused on providing orientation for the CSIR-UGC examination and insights into higher studies. The program, conducted by Mr. Vineesh Sebastian, Assistant Professor at Nirmala College, Koothuparamba, was designed for 100 botany students. Held on 15-11-2020, this initiative aimed to offer students comprehensive guidance on preparing for the CSIR-UGC exam and to explore the avenues of advanced education in the field of botany.

Objectives of the Program

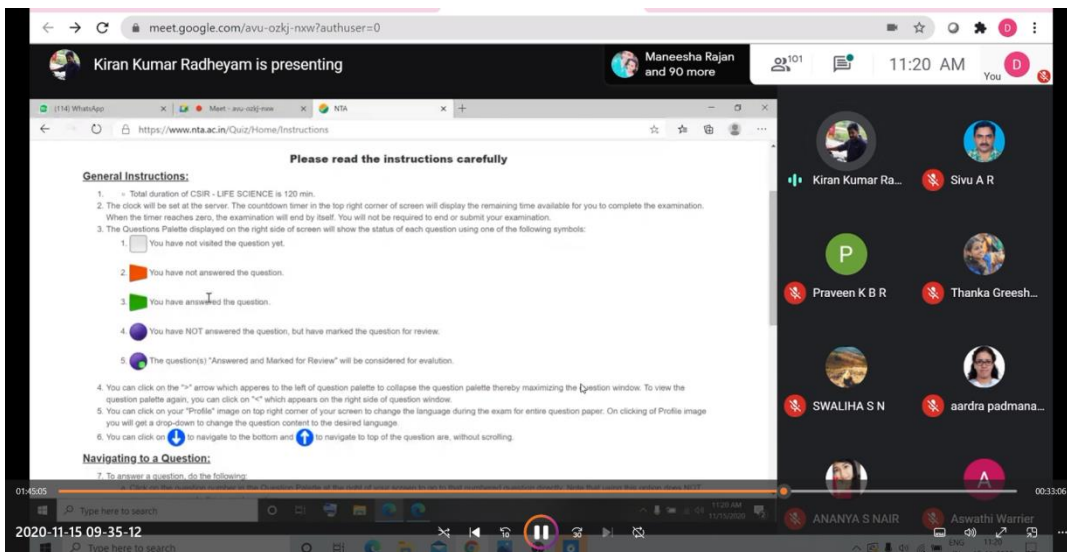
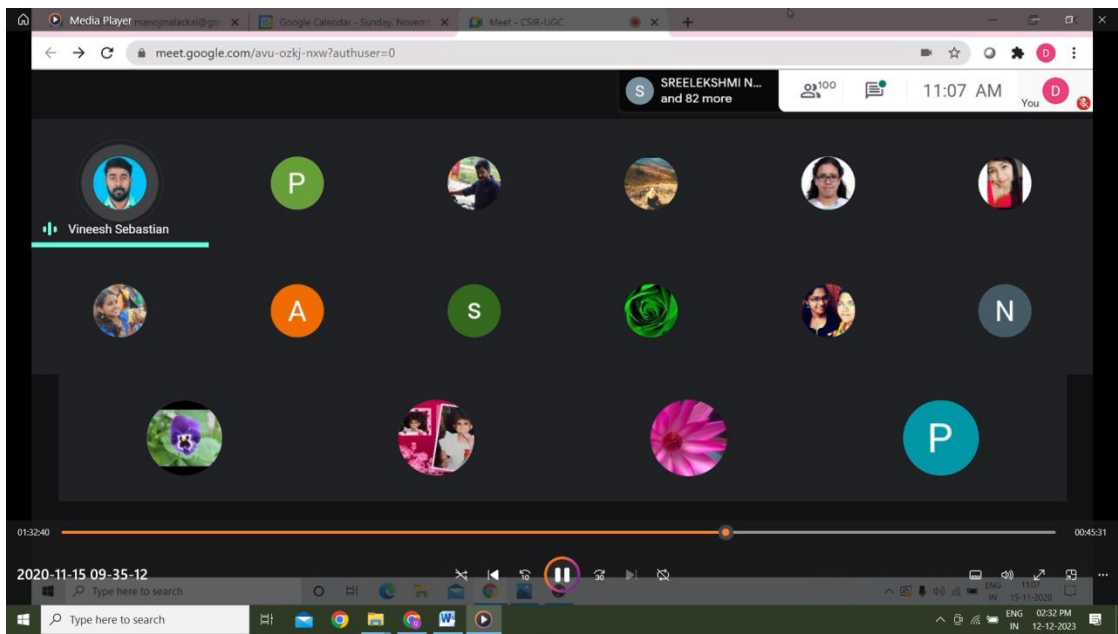
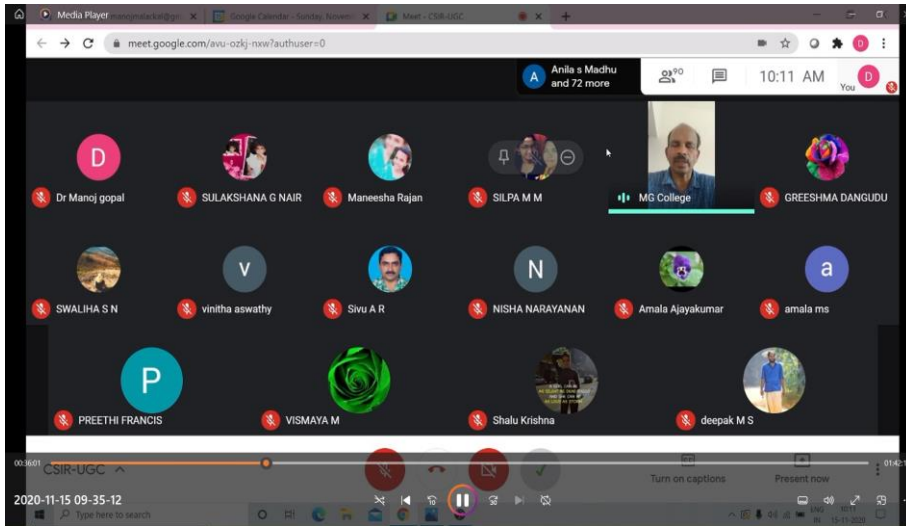
The primary objectives of this orientation program were threefold. Firstly, to demystify the CSIR-UGC exam by providing in-depth insights into its format, syllabus, and effective preparation strategies. Secondly, to guide students on the various pathways for higher studies in botany, including specializations and research opportunities. Lastly, to equip students with the knowledge and resources needed for informed decision-making about their academic and professional futures, emphasizing the integration of their botany education with real-world applications.

Program Outline

The program commenced with an introductory session by Mr. Vineesh Sebastian, who elaborated on the importance and intricacies of the CSIR-UGC examination. This session was followed by a detailed discussion on study techniques, time management, and tips for tackling the exam effectively. The latter part of the program was dedicated to higher studies in botany, where Mr. Vineesh and invited experts from Life Science Academy discussed various specializations, research opportunities, and career prospects. Interactive Q&A sessions were interspersed throughout the program, allowing students to engage directly with the speakers.

Outcomes of the Program

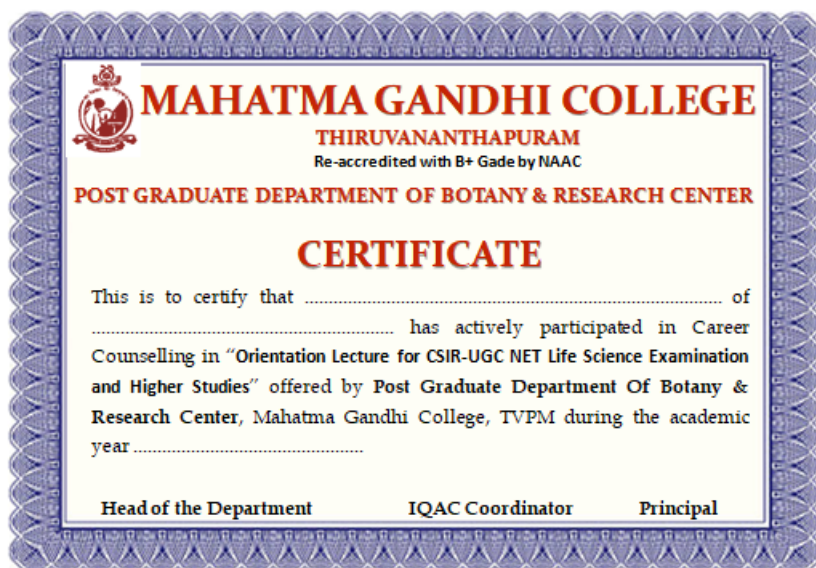



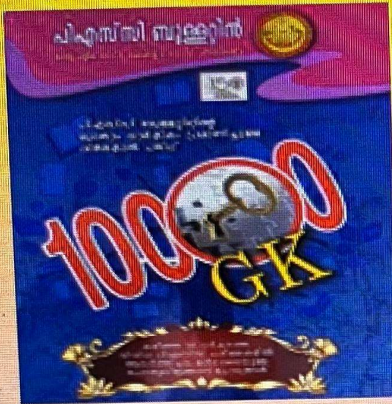
