1)Talk on Research Methodology

Department of Psychology in collaboration with Department of Mathematics conducted a Research Methodology session on 25.8.2022. Session was handled by Dr Vineetha M of Statistics Department. 4) Workshop on Ethics and Methodologies in Research

Principal Dr. Nanthiyath Gopalakrishnan inaugurated the programme. Head of the department of Physics Dr. Padma Kumar H presided over the function.

The inauguration was followed by first scientific session by Dr. Vaisakhan Thampi D.S on the topic “Standard Practices in Doing and Publishing Research”. A Brief report of the TWO DAY WORKSHOP ON THE ART OF RESEARCH WRITING conducted on 27 February 2020 & 28 February 2020 at the Seminar Hall of Mahatma Gandhi College, Thiruvananthapuram.

A two day workshop on *The Art of Research Writing* hosted by IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell), Mahatma Gandhi College was organized in collaboration with the Department of English and Department of Zoology on 27 February 2020 & 28 February 2020 at the Seminar Hall of the college. The workshop primarily aimed at featuring the varied aspects and the stages ingrained in the process of research and unraveling the art hidden in research writing. The workshop was mainly intended for Postgraduate students from science and humanities. It was part of the crucial initiative taken by IQAC to create awareness among students regarding the importance of research and to provide them ample guidelines to sharpen their skills in this field.

The workshop had a grand opening with the inaugural session which began at 10.00 am on 27 February 2020, following the registration of students to the workshop at 9.30 am onwards. 92 students from Humanities and Languages got themselves registered on the first day of this venture. The inaugural session began with a prayer by selected students, followed by Acharyanusmaranam. The IQAC Coordinator of the College, Dr. Balamurali.R.S who was the brain behind this endeavor, offered a splendid welcome to the gathering. He stated the problems encountered by the Postgraduate students such as plagiarism, documentation and need for proper methodology, as they involve themselves in the process of research. The Principal, Dr. M.S. Anil Kumar inaugurated the workshop and delivered the inaugural address in which he stated that it was really a magnificent step taken in instigating the research capabilities of the students. He wished all success for the workshop and acknowledged that this initiative was certainly first of its kind, and congratulated the proud initiative taken up by the IQAC in this regard. Dr. Vidya Rajagopal, Research Committee convener and HOD of English paid her felicitations for the majestic success of the programme. She spoke about the necessity as well as inevitability of research and how research is not only an 'art' but also a 'craft' which could be sharpened through practice. The Vote of thanks for the dignitaries on and off the dais was offered by Dr. Chitra.V.S., Coordinator of the workshop.

The first day of the workshop (27 February 2020) was devoted to the research interest of the students from the Humanities stream. The first session was headed by Dr. Nibu Thomson, Assistant Professor of English, Nirmala College, Muvattupuzha. He gave an extensive detailing of the steps involved in research-how to find a research problem from the surroundings itself, the hypothesis formulation, the importance of documenting the sources from the very beginning of research without getting caught in the hurdle of plagiarism, the sources from which data can be collected including print and online, the Do's and Don'ts in research and concluded by giving an idea to the students regarding the importance of documenting the sources as an integral part of research.

The second session started at 1.30pm, after the lunch and the resource person for this session was Dr. George Sebastian, Assistant Professor of English, Newmann College, Thodupuzha. His session provided the students with information regarding the practical issues faced in the way of research, tactful selection of topics for research, how to make research an interesting and pleasurable experience along with the usual hurdles in research and its final outcome.

28 February 2020, the second day of the workshop, mainly targeted the Postgraduate students from the Science Departments. 82 students registered themselves for the workshop on the second day. The morning session started at 10.00 am utilizing the research expertise of Dr. M.R. Sudarsana Kumar, Former Principal & Adjunct Faculty, FUCOS. His talk elaborated the methodology adopted in research in science, the contributions of great researchers, their experiences, the recognitions obtained in this regard and stressed that age is no bar for a researcher if there is a will.

The second session for the day began after the lunch break at 1.30pm and the resource person was Dr. Kurien Abraham, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Aquatic Biology, University of Kerala. He mainly concentrated on Report writing and its importance in research, the significance of publishing articles and the tips for writing articles and getting it published in reputed journals.

The workshop came to a close with the feedback of the students about the workshop. Most of the students commented that it was highly useful and capable of instilling in their minds, a positive attitude towards research, for beginners like them. Participants remarked that they gained valuable pieces of information on how to approach a research problem, the opportunity to extract data from various sources or networks and to learn to explore ideas from the expert resource persons. On the whole, the workshop implanted a seed of research in the minds of students and the valuable resources they obtained as part of this is expected to water and nurture their ideas, with the visible results they will produce as part of their research areas, in the near future.

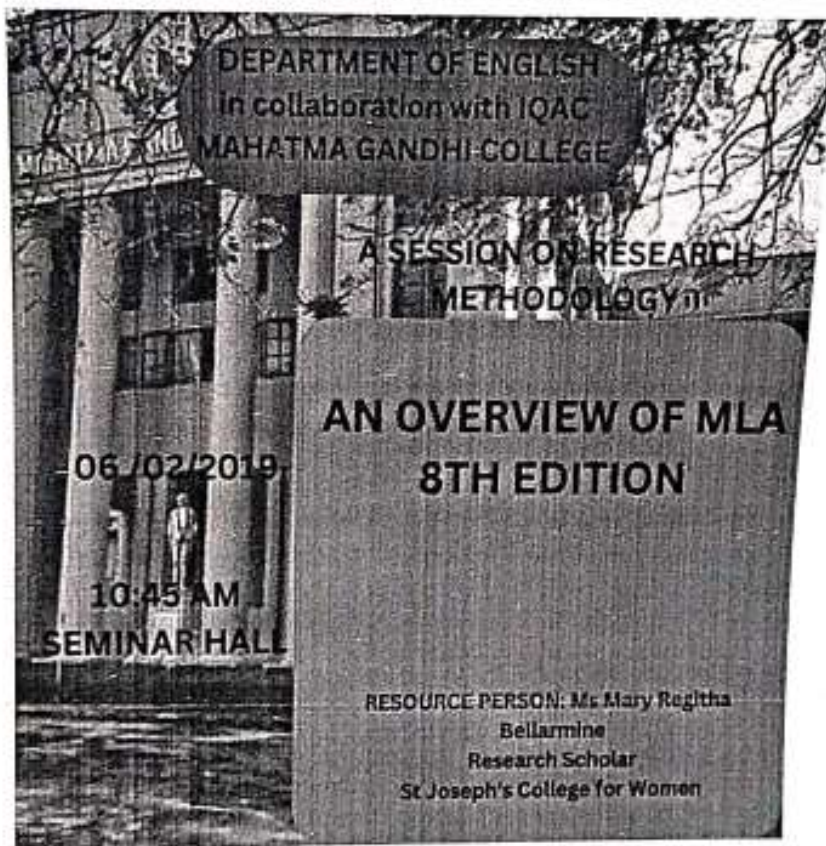
A BRIEF REPORT OF THE WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY



The programme came to an end at 1:30 PM with National Anthem.

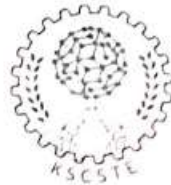

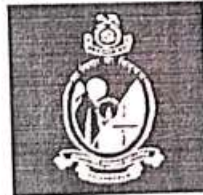
