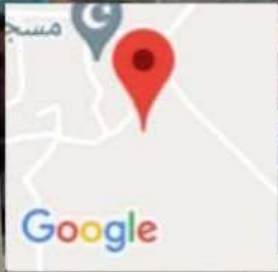



Purview of Psychology conducted by Dept of Psychology on 15 and 16th February, 2022

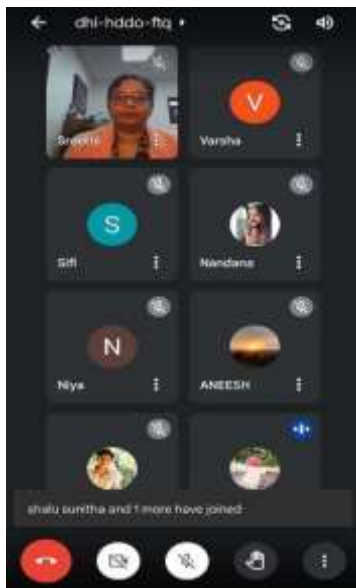

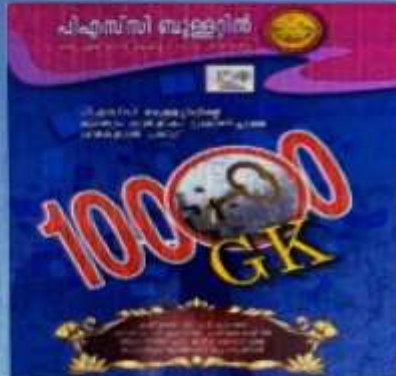
