

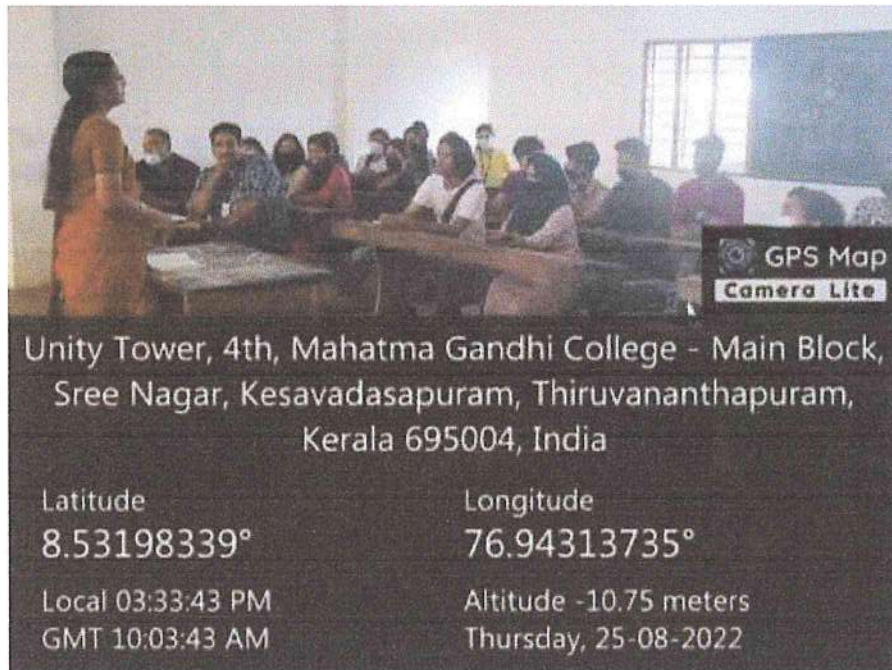

Around 30 students which includes PG and research students attended the programme. All the sessions were interactive. Brochure and photos are attached below.

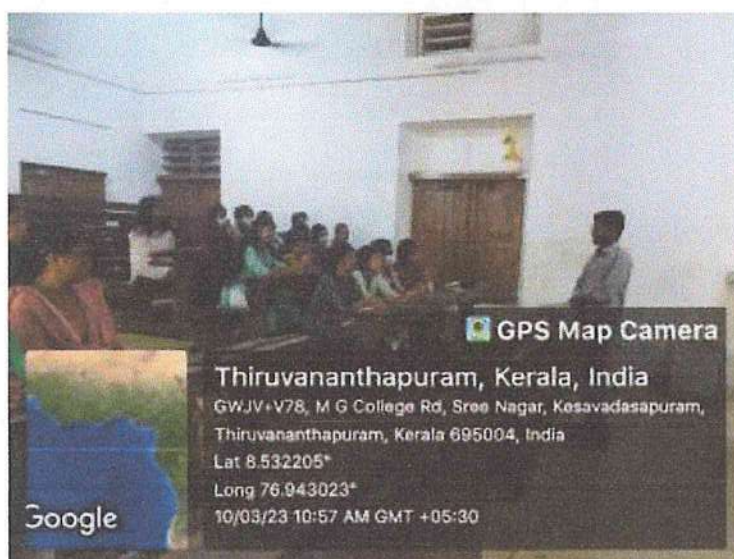

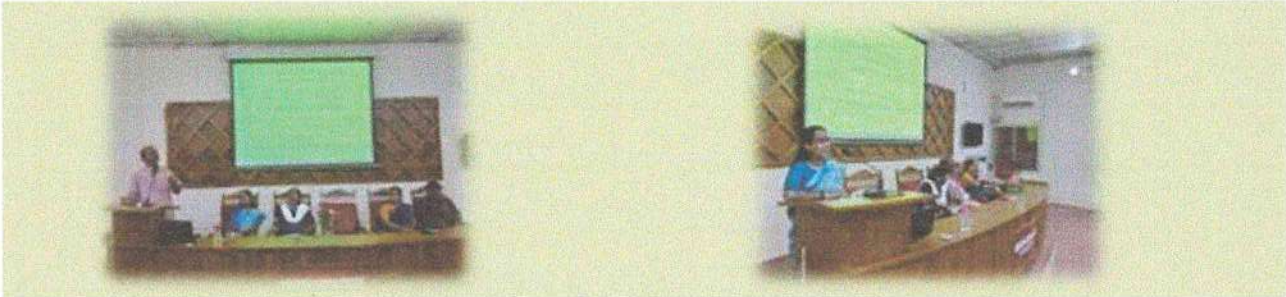
6) Report of one day seminar on Intellectual property rights" on 13/03/2023

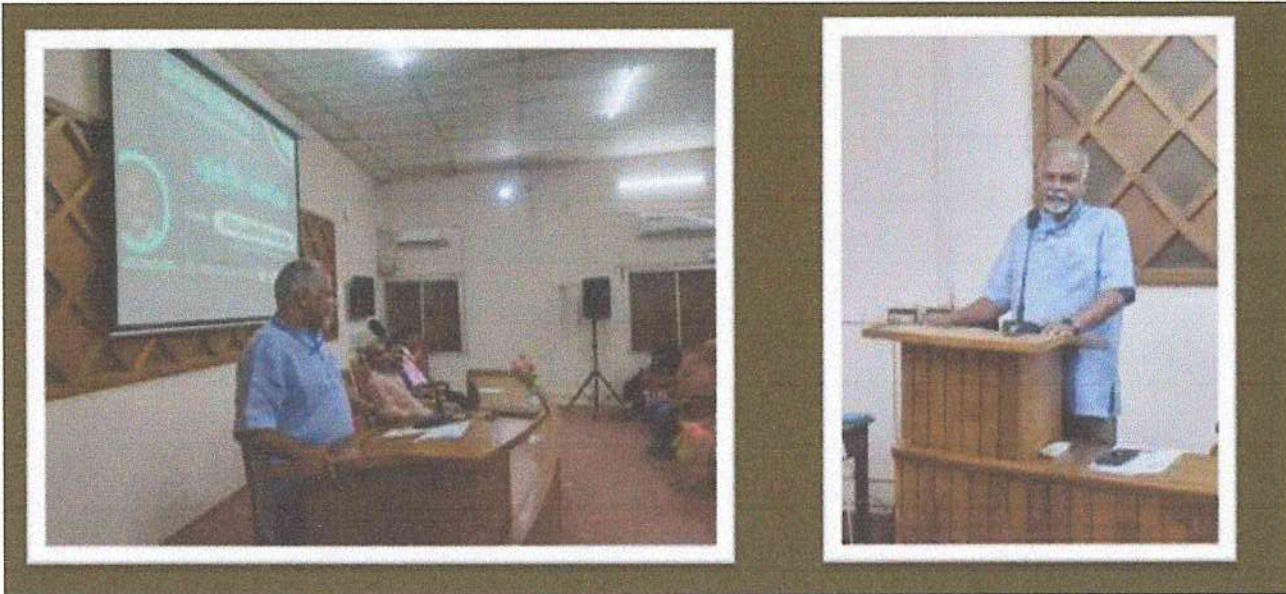
TRANSLATION OF THE ABOVE REPORT

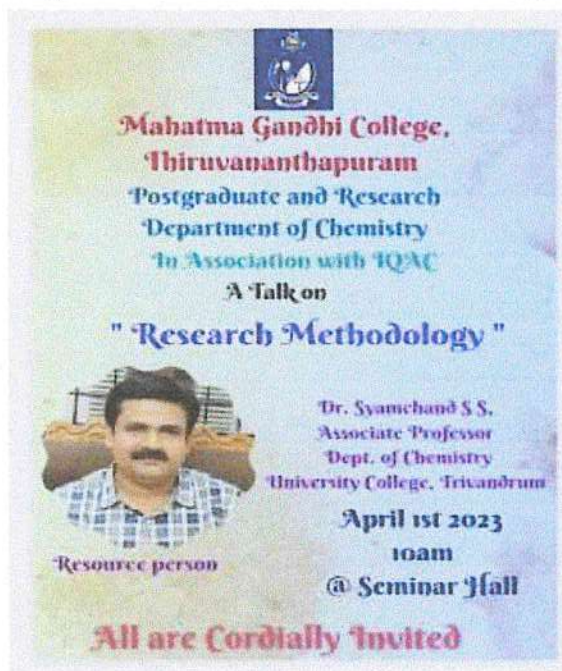
17)REPORT OF TALK ON 'RESEARCH METHODOLOGY' on 01/04/2023
