Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>During the challenging times of COVID-19, the education system's shared vision acknowledged that throughout the pandemic, tutors and students need to be motivated to modify online teaching-learning platforms to meet contemporary educational needs. During the pandemic, appropriate steps were taken to conduct online classes so that the syllabus of the entire course could be covered within the stipulated time. Several online sessions with question-and-answer sessions were conducted by the College to familiarize the faculty with online tools, techniques, processes, and platforms. During the lockdown, the teachers participated in technology-based education programmes hosted by several universities in partnership with the UGC. All the teachers were instructed by the Head of the Institution to conduct online classes, i.e., conducting teaching-learning sessions with the help of ICT and IOT. All the teachers had developed the practice of using a lot of open-source solutions like Google Meet, Google Classroom, Zoom, you tube and WhatsApp platforms.</p> <p>Accordingly the teachers conducted online classes as per scheduled time table. Teachers were able to convey the students through email or WhatsApp about the time and topic of the online classes. Teachers also sent their live video tutorials on YouTube channels and also the study material in the Google Classroom and WhatsApp group. Tutorials/projects, class tests and internal assessments which comprise the formal evaluative process were also conducted through these platforms. Students were encouraged to interact with faculty beyond classroom hours for doubt-clearing, curricular discussions and for counselling (stress due to pandemic). The progress of delivery of curriculum is regularly monitored by HODs, Principal and the IQAC.</p> <p>In order to get the students prepared for the end semester examinations, teachers shared study materials, set of question papers and provided home assignments to the respective groups as well as through Google classroom. The students were given ample scope to revise what they have studied and in return were asked to give proper feedback for improving the existing teaching- learning process. Students were also encouraged to ask queries and raise doubts related to the topics to the teachers concerned. No classes without any strong reason were postponed or cancelled. Moreover, the end semester examination, internal evaluation and many international / national / state level webinars were conducted by various departments. Special lectures delivered by eminent scholars on topics related to the curriculum further intensified students' learning experience. Teachers were unable to perform online practical sessions during the lockdown time, because it required methodical demonstration of the entire process in front of the students. As a result, in the second half of the semester, teaching was switched to a blended method of online/offline for 1/3 of the campus students, to complete the practical sessions, examinations, projects, and other tasks in the offline mode strictly following the COVID-19 SOP.</p>
