Annual Report 2017 -18

Mahatma Gandhi College, the institution in memory of the father of the nation, established in the year 1948, by Sri. Mannathu Padmanabhan is one of the leading institutions of higher education in Kerala. The College accredited by NAAC with an 'A' grade in 2004 was reaccredited in the second cycle again with an 'A' grade (CGPA 3.16). The institution was also one among the three colleges in Kerala and one in 40 Colleges in India to qualify for the second phase of CPE in 2016.

The college has 13 UG programmes, 10 PG programmes and seven Research Centers approved by the University of Kerala. The research committee organizes research augmenting activities for students and faculty. The College has a dynamic and enterprising faculty that numbers around 111 of whom 25 are Associate Professors and 86 are Assistant Professors. 79 of our teachers are PhD holders and 8 of them have M.Phil. degree. The vibrant student community hailing mostly from the outskirts of Trivandrum comes to 2365 in number. There are 121 students pursuing the PhD programme, 361 students in the PG programme (of which 306 are girls) and 1883 students (of which 1142 are girls) in the UG programme. Girl students far outnumber boy students in the campus.

As for the performance of our students in university examinations, the result analysis shows that the pass percentage is well above the University average. There has been delay in the publication of results by the University and this has adversely affected the student community.

The Admission process this year, as in the previous years, was carried out in strict accordance with the University and Government norms. 304 seats were earmarked for reservation category and that was strictly maintained.

Right from the beginning of this academic year Mahatma Gandhi College witnessed a plethora of events organized by the students and teachers of different departments of our College.

The World Environment Day is observed internationally on 5th June every year. This year, the Environment day celebrations at Mahatma Gandhi College were organized by all departments. The programme organized by the Postgraduate and Research Department of Zoology from 5th to 9th June was inaugurated by the Principal Dr. M.R. Sudarsanakumar by planting tree saplings in the campus. This was followed by a pledge on protecting the environment. There was an invited talk by Dr. Santhi S, a freelance ecologist and environmental educator; on the topic 'Reconnecting to Nature and Rediscovering Our Wild Soul' and another by Dr. P. Manoharan Pillai, former Professor of N.S.S college, Kottiyam on "Ecospirituality". Further Quiz, Painting and Flash presentation competitions were held on 7th June 2017. Mr Balashankar, a forest officer from the Department of Forestry, gave an enlightening talk which dealt with the different types of forests, the need for conservation and human –wildlife conflicts.

Dr. Alex Mathew gave a talk on 'Self Motivation' on 06/06/2017 organized on behalf of 'Walk with Scholar' Programme.

21stJune 2017 was observed as International Yoga Day by the Department of Psychology. There was a Yoga demonstration and workshop by Sri. Suneesh, an alumnus. The programme was a combined effort of the Department and the NSS unit of the College. Around 100 students attended the programme.

The Department of Economics had their students addressed by Dr. Arun Sudarsan, a post-doctoral fellow from the University of Singapore on 'Career Prospects after Graduation' on 24.06.2017. This was followed by a talk by Dr. C P Aravindakshan, Principal, University College on 'Education and Culture' as part of the valedictory function of 'Walk with Scholar' programme.

The Department of Hindi, in order to inspire students to read classics, observed, 'Vayana Varam' from 12/6/2017 to 19/6/2017.
